



## 1 BOOKING

Confirmation in writing is required, together with a deposit of £100 (or as specifically requested), returnable only if a minimum of 30 days notice is given for cancellation. Any cancellation of a booking **must** be made in writing.

Confirmation of numbers attending is required one week in advance of your visit **otherwise the minimum number for which you will be charged will be the number of players shown on the booking form.** It would be helpful to us to know if players are travelling by coach. Please be aware that you may be sharing your day with another group of visitors.

## 2 FEES – Society Rates

- a) Minimum of 12 players.

*Please notify us in advance of any special dietary requirements.*

- b) Evening meals will only be served for groups of at least 20.

- c) We regret that members are not able to sign in guests for a reduced green fee.

- d) We regret we are unable to offer concessionary rates (e.g. County Cards) for society visitors.

- e) Courtesies will be given to serving Club Captains and PGA Professionals if visits are arranged *in advance*. Courtesies will not be granted on the day.

## 3 ON ARRIVAL – The clubhouse opens at 0730hrs.

Security access systems are in use in the men's and ladies' locker rooms. Would society organisers please make themselves known to the Secretary, duty Steward or Course Marshall who will allocate the security access code in operation for the day. Society organisers will be held responsible for their society members' behaviour both on and off the course.

## 4 TROLLEYS/BUGGIES



Trolleys may be rented from the Professional's Shop. To reserve a power trolley please telephone 01428 604458.

Please be prepared to carry in the event of a trolley ban being implemented.

Buggies are not permitted on the course with the exception of the Course Marshall's vehicle.

## **5 HANDICAPS – Proof of handicap may be requested.**

Players are expected to be well versed in course etiquette.

For societies, to help speed of play please ensure that your lower handicap players go off first.

## **6 GPS SYSTEMS**

Measuring Devices – GPS systems – Rule 14.3

Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measure distance only. If such a device also measures other conditions it will constitute a breach of Rule 14.3, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

## **7 HIRE OF COURSE MARKER PINS**

We can supply longest drive or nearest pin markers with a minimum of 48hrs notice.

## **8 PLAY – From yellow tees only**

Societies may play regulation singles, foursomes, greensomes, or three balls only.

**Fourballs or Texas scrambles are not permitted.**

Please use the enclosed starting sheet and, if possible, give the completed sheet/sheets(or your own version) to the Course Marshall on arrival who will confirm your starting tee and times. We reserve the right to change previously advised starting tees on the day.

## **9 SPEED OF PLAY – will be monitored by the Course Marshall**

Starting times must be adhered to. It is important to keep pace with the match in front, not just ahead of those behind. In order to enable uninterrupted play the 10<sup>th</sup> hole will be closed (1<sup>st</sup> if starting from the 10<sup>th</sup>) so that society members may pass through without delay. If gaps occur and others move on to the course, the delay to the back-markers may well mean no play for them in the second round. No refunds will be given if this should happen.

## **10 HALFWAY HOUSE**

At the 10<sup>th</sup> tee the halfway house facility will be available for hot/cold drinks, hot/cold sandwiches and snacks. Please remind your players to take some cash with them should they wish to purchase anything.

## **11 DRESS**

Shorts must be tailored, not less than mid-thigh in length, and worn with knee length socks. Short socks may be worn if white. All shirts, which must have a collar, should be tucked in at the waist. T-shirts, shell/track suits, jeans, leggings and training shoes are not permitted, nor are 'cargo' type patch pocket trousers.

Shoes that have been worn for golf must not be worn in the clubhouse. Headgear is to be removed on entry to the clubhouse.



Players are requested to freshen up before using the clubhouse. Golfing dress as defined above is permitted but jacket with a tie, cravat, or roll-neck sweater must be worn by gentlemen in the dining room in the evenings. Beyond the locker rooms golf shoes are permitted in the Summer Bar during the months of BST only (accessed only from the patio).

Golf shoes are not permitted elsewhere in the clubhouse. Ankle length socks must be worn with shoes in the clubhouse. Sandals are not permitted.

A correspondingly good standard of dress is required for ladies on the course and in the clubhouse.

## **12 PORTABLE TELEPHONES**

The use of mobile telephones is **not** permitted in the clubhouse or on the course. They must be switched off and only used on the course in cases of emergency.

## **13 PAYMENT**

For societies fees are payable *in full* on the day by cash or cheque. Most credit and debit cards are accepted (but not American Express). We regret we are unable to accept payment for bar purchases by credit/debit card from individual society members.

Casual green fees are collected in the Professional's Shop.

## **14 GENERAL**

Please advise if you require the use of a prize table, easel for leader boards, etc. Scorecards can be forwarded in advance if required.



## **15 LOCATION**

Situated 1½ miles north of the A3 on the A287: M25, junction 10, approx. 25 miles.

The M25 and A3 are very congested during the rush hour so please allow plenty of time for your journey. Please also note that the A3 tunnel is under construction and can result in significant disruption to traffic in the area. To avoid this it is advised, if possible, to approach the Club from the Farnham direction on the A287. (Please also refer to our web site for details and map).
